Museums Assistance Program

Objectives:

- ✓ Facilitate Canadians' access to our heritage
- ✓ Foster preservation of Canada's cultural heritage
- ✓ Preservation of representative collections of Aboriginal cultural heritage
- ✓ Foster professional knowledge, skills and practices related to key museum functions

Who can apply:

- ✓ Incorporated non-profit Canadian museums
- ✓ Museum associations Non-profit Canadian service organizations relating to museum sector
- ✓ Other levels of government, academic, cultural institutions with principal mandate linked to heritage.
- ✓ Aboriginal governing bodies with mandate to preserve and support Aboriginal heritage (for Aboriginal Heritage component)

MAP Components

Access to Heritage

- Supports production and circulation of travelling exhibitions across different geographic regions of Canada

Aboriginal Heritage

- Supports preservation, presentation and management of Aboriginal cultural heritage, and increases public awareness and understanding of Aboriginal cultural heritage.

Collections Management

- To improve knowledge, skills and practices related to key museum functions.

Deadline: November 1

Exhibition Circulation Fund

- Assists museums with costs of borrowing a travelling exhibition from another museum or federal heritage institution.
- **Year-round intake**

Movable Cultural Property Grants

Movable Cultural Property grants provide financial assistance to designated museums, art galleries, libraries, archives and related organizations to purchase important cultural property.

Grants can be used to purchase cultural property:

- ✓ for which an export permit has been denied; or
- ✓ that is important to Canada's national heritage and available for purchase outside the country.

Applicants are encouraged to contribute 50% or more towards the purchase of the cultural property.

Year-round intake

Young Canada Works – Heritage

Objective:

- ✓ Helping young students and graduates to gain the skills and experience they need to establish careers in heritage organizations.

Two program streams:

- ✓ Summer and short-term jobs for students
- ✓ Internships to graduates 30 years and under

Third-party delivered by:

- ✓ Canadian Museums Association
- ✓ Canadian Council of Archives
- ✓ National Trust for Canada
- ✓ ASTED

Application Deadlines:

- ✓ Summer and short-term jobs – February 1
- ✓ Internships – Determined by delivery organizations (typically February 15)
